The owner of Rice Restaurant had a very clear vision as to how he wanted his restaurant to look. SC&A and the project architect worked closely to make the owners vision a reality. A new 4500 square foot Asian sushi specialty restaurant combined traditional building materials and state of the art materials to create a chic inviting urban themed deco. The facility seats 120 at tables, and 25 more in the private dining area. The private dining area is separated from the main seating area by custom sliding glass panels. The 40 foot long bar contains custom colored tops and customized lighting for additional seating. SC&A has experience in the restaurant industry, which was highly valued on this project especially in coordinating installation of kitchen equipment and exhaust hoods. This was a challenging building to build architecturally due to the multiple roof levels, angles and corners of the design. Installation and pre-manufactured metal panels across 3 sides of the building proved to be very difficult, yet SC&A contractors did a superb job. Since opening day, comments on both the interior and the exterior have been very positive.
