This site was re-developed for the purpose of bringing people together in a single site to leverage the synergies among the company's different R&D teams in the US. The property is made up of 78,000 square feet of laboratory space and support services, including conference and training facilities. Extensive renovations and new construction were required for the transformation of the existing building, including the installation of over seven miles of pipe to transport gas. The modern industrial architecture of the new facility features lots of open interior spaces and utilizes natural light introduced through glass curtain walls and skylights. The facility was completed in January 2007 and is valued at \$21 million.
